The conference will be held on **September 24-26**, **2015** in Prague, in the historic building of the <u>Czech Academy of Sciences</u> (AVČR, <u>Národní 1009</u>, <u>Prague</u>, the Czech Republic).

Presentation modalities

There will be 5 presentation modalities:

a) Plenary (40 min.)

The plenary presenters are kindly asked to restrict their presentations to 35 minutes followed by 5 minutes for discussion led by the chair of the session.

b) Regular paper (20 min.)

The paper presenters are kindly asked to restrict their presentations to 15 minutes followed by 5 minutes for discussion led by the chair of the session.

c) Workshop (30 min.)

Workshop sessions must include the <u>active audience participation</u> experiencing and discussing tasks provided by the workshop facilitator.

d) Poster

Posters are invited on any of the themes listed above. They may be any size up to a maximum of A1 (594mm x 840mm) or equivalent made up of separate sheets.

e) Virtual papers.

The authors who cannot come to CLEaR2015 in person are invited to present their papers on any of the themes listed above in the form of a videopresentation/a ppt presentation/ a digital paper in the virtual session of the conference.

Working language

The official language of the conference is **English**.

Publications

All the accepted abstracts and papers will be published in **two ISBN publications**. They both will be included in Google Scholar and sent to be reviewed for the inclusion in the ISI Conference Proceedings Citation Index.

Papers approved by the reviewers will be published in the **JoLaCE**: *Journal of Language and Cultural Education* (ISSN 1339-4045 print, 1339-4584 online).

LUNCH ON 25 SEPTEMBER (12:30 - 14:00)



KLEMENTINUM EXCURSION (www.klementinum.com)

All registered attendants are invited to join the guided tour of Klementinum (meeting point: 25 September 2015, 18:30 in front of the AV ČR). The tour will take app. 1 hour (including the visit of the Tower) and will be guided in English.

Klementinum is the historical building, established as the Jesuit College in the 16th century by Ferdinand I, and nowadays the Czech National Library resides there. The large complex of Klementinum is located on the Old Town side of the Charles Bridge in the historical centre of Prague. Klementinum was built on an area of two hectares and is one of the largest building complexes in Europe.

The most attractive parts of the sightseeing tour include the <u>Astronomical Tower</u>, with a beautiful view of the historical centre of Prague, <u>Meridian Hall</u> a unique room previously used for determining noon and <u>Baroque Library Hall</u> with beautiful frescoes and several historically valuable globes. In case there is no event taking place in the <u>Mirror Chapel</u>, it will be possible to see it as part of the tour. However, this option cannot be guaranteed in advance.











Prague Guided Tour (26 SEPTEMBER, 10:00 - 14:00)

All registered attendants are invited to join the guided tour of the historical

centre of Prague.

The meeting point: 10:00 in front of the AV ČR. The tour combines a minibus ride and walking and will be guided in English.

Places to be seen include:

the Prague Castle and Hradcany, Mala Strana (Lesser town), the Charles Bridge, the Czech National Theatre, the Kampa Island, the "John Lennon wall", the Old Town area, the Jewish Quater, the Old Jewish Cemetery (from the outside), the Old-New Synagogue, the Wenceslas Square, the New Town, the Municipal House of Prague, the Old Town Square and the famous astronomical clock, the Prague City Hall, the Rudolfinum, the Charles Square, the New Town hall, the Church of Prague Infant, the Loreta, St. Vitus Cathedral, the Old Royal Palace, and more.
