Presentation modalities

There are 5 presentation modalities:

- a) *Plenary (40 min.):* The plenary presenters are kindly asked to restrict their presentations to 35 minutes followed by 5 minutes for discussion led by the chair of the session.
- b) <u>Regular paper (20 min.):</u> The paper presenters are kindly asked to restrict their presentations to 15 minutes followed by 5 minutes for discussion led by the chair of the session.
- c) <u>Workshop (30 min.)</u>: Workshop sessions must include <u>active audience participation</u> through experiencing and discussing tasks provided by the workshop facilitator.
- d) <u>Posters:</u> Posters will be displayed and presented in the poster session on Wednesday afternoon in Sala Baratto (Chair: Roman Cancinov).
- e) <u>Virtual papers:</u> LLCE2016 welcomes also contributions from the authors who cannot come to Venice in person. Their papers/ppt presentations / video presentations are published in the virtual session of the conference. The session will be active from July 12th, 2016 to December 31st, 2016 and is available at: http://www.jolace.com/conferences/conferences-2016/llce2016/publications-and-follow-up/. Author guidelines:

- To submit the papers, you may either fill out the online "Final Paper Submission Form" on LLCE2016 conference website or go directly to one of the journals. In any case, please follow the author guidelines on journals respective websites.
- To be published in either of the journals, the paper must undergo the <u>double-blind reviewing process</u>. The authors will be contacted by journal editors and informed about the status of their papers.
- Papers will only be published in the LLCE2016 publications if at least one of the authors of the paper completed their registration for the LLCE2016 conference.
- Both journals are published by de Gruyter Open, they are free of access and their publication is covered by publication fees paid by contributors/paper authors. LLCE2016 conference participants will be charged 30% discount of publication fee.

Registration

LLCE2016 conference attendees should register at the registration/information desk which is open on both days of the conference (12 – 13 July) **from 8:15 p.m. till 12:00 p.m**. Duration: 2 hours


The tour will be guided in English.
